We look forward to speaking to many of you who have made parents evening appointments next week.





This is refundable if the trip is cancelled!


Birthday Cakes/Sweets

Government funded Holiday Activities and Food (HAF)

The Department for Education (DfE) is providing funding to local authorities to coordinate a programme that provides healthy food and enriching activities to eligible children during the 2021 Easter, Summer and Christmas Holidays.

This is known as the Holiday Activities and Food (HAF) Programme.

Places will be available at a range of holiday club providers, and offer eligible children the opportunity to attend sessions 4 hours per day for 4 days per week over Summer and for 4 days over the Christmas holidays.

Eligibility

School aged children from any of the following categories are eligible to access the programme:

- Children in receipt of benefits related free school meals
- Children in need
- Child protection
- Looked after or previously looked after school aged children

How to apply

Parents or carers of eligible children are invited to apply for a place online using the form found on the following link

A check will be carried out to ensure each child's eligibility for means tested free school meal provision and a confirmation email will be sent to be used as proof of eligibility.
