Dear Parents,

Welcome back to the final term of the school year and our exciting topic 'Where in the World is Wally?' where our focus will be on Geography, Science and Design and Technology. Over the next few weeks we will be going on a world tour searching for Wally in various different countries and learning more about them. We hope that you find the topic web gives you a brief insight into some of the activities that we will be doing this term in the other areas of the curriculum.

In English, we will be completing our own research using non-fiction texts and will be using this research to write fact files about different countries. We will also be writing descriptions of Wally and places he visits as a stimulus for our sentence writing. The children will continue to focus on the use of capital letters, full stops, adjectives, conjunctions and key word spellings in their writing.

In Maths, we will be concentrating on ensuring that all children have achieved the Maths objectives that you will find listed in the back of the reading record books. We will also be continuing to work on recalling number bonds/facts/times-tables and encouraging the children to use these effectively to help them calculate quickly. The children will continue to work on solving a range of word problems, knowing which operation is needed by drawing pictures to show understanding and to help solve the problem. This term we will also work on fractions, geometry, money and time.

Keep an eye on the school website or newsletter for information about events in the coming term. Please make sure your children bring their P.E. kit (including trainers and daps) in school as our P.E. days are now Tuesday and Thursday. Weather permitting, the children will be outside so suitable footwear will be needed.

Thank you for your continued support with reading, number bonds, times tables and spellings. Please continue to support your child with these at home.
