Christmas

We will be:

- Using a range of media to create firework scenes
- Building our name to create a firework rocket
- Creating a firework scene for display and re-enacting our own experiences
- Exploring our autumn finds and sharing the story Leaf Man as a class
- Making leaf graphs, counting and sorting leaves
- Composition of numbers 1,2,3
- Practising fine motor cutting skills
- Reinforcing pencil grip and writing our names independently
- Completing STEM activities to make sculptures using sticks
- Introducing the children to four new sounds and practising our blending of CVC words

We will be:

- Learning why it is important to be respectful and the meaning behind wearing a poppy
- Using clay to create a Diva lamp
- Creating Rangoli patterns
- Comparing different cultures and religions
- Learning and sequencing the story of Rama and Sita
- Understanding the importance of charity and thinking of others
- Composition of numbers 1,2,3
- Subitising numbers to 3 and recognising different ways to make 3
- Exploring questioning vocabulary to expand on our back and forth conversation skills
- Explore moving in different ways during physical development lessons

We will be:

- Learning and ordering the months of the year
- Writing birthday invitations
- Making lists for party food
- Following instructions to make party food
- Recognising numbers to 31 when learning our birth date.
- Reading and discussing stories related to birthdays such as 'The Birthday Crown' and 'The little yellow chicken'
- Composition of numbers 4 and 5
- Counting place settings, spoons and so on
- Problem solving e.g. how many plates for 4 people
- Acting out different amounts through jumps, claps and movements
- Hold a 'party' as a year group to celebrate birthdays

We will be:

- Learning the Christmas Story
- Designing and creating Christmas cards
- Decorating our classroom with our own decorations.
- Learning Christmas songs and hymns
- Learning and performing our Christmas Nativity
- Recognising and subitising numbers to 6. 7 & 8 and recognising different ways to make to make them alongside being able to order the numbers
- Use money in the post office role playing
- Counting and sorting letters through post office role play
- Develop our fine motor skills doing things like threading and sewing.
